The new Activities Committee brings neighbors together with events that celebrate the community and create memorable experiences beyond typical HOA expectations.

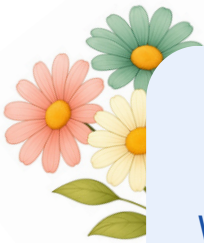

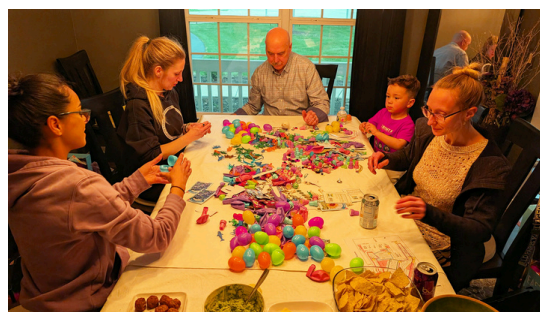

# Other News



The City of Crystal Lake is in the process of replacing all of the water meters in the City's public water distribution system.

You will receive a notification postcard via mail from Veregy LLC when they are in your area of the City. This notification will include a phone number to call and a website where you can self-schedule an appointment to have your meter replaced. No one should ask you for payment.

Meter replacement will require access to each residence or business, as meters are typically located in basements, crawl spaces, or utility closets that could include your furnace or water heater



## *Slow Down!*

When traveling through the neighborhood, please lower your speed and remain alert for pedestrians. If you notice a vehicle speeding, we encourage you to visit the Crystal Lake homepage, click on 'Traffic Concern,' and report it to the local authorities.



## *School Bus Safety*

Let's stay alert in school zones and near bus stops! Remember, when a school bus has its red lights flashing, you MUST stop in both directions. This ensures the safety of children getting on and off the bus. Stay safe and aware!
